2010 Non-Profit I-Can-Do-It-All Award

Nominee must meet all of the following criteria:

- Currently works in the non-profit public relations field in the metro St. Louis area
- Currently is responsible for executing projects in each of the following areas:
Development, Public Relations, Volunteer Management/Special Events
- Has more than two years of experience in the non-profit field
- Has proven ability through body of work and/or specific outcomes
- Demonstrates a creative approach to her/his job

Application must include:

- Nominee's résumé/work history
- Minimum of three written descriptions/explanations of Development, Public Relations, Volunteer Management/Special Events projects/efforts in which the nominee played a critical role
- Written description/explanation of the nominee's creative approach to projects
- Two letters of recommendation supporting the nomination
- Personal statement from the nominee (not to exceed 100 words) indicating why she/he should be considered for this award

Nomination materials are due **Friday, April 20, 2010.**

CSPRC's Board of Directors will select the award recipient. The honoree must receive at least 75% of the Board's favorable vote.
